**LARRY COBB COPE**, 60, died Saturday, Oct. 19, 2002, at Duke University Medical Center. A memorial service will be at Fellowship Baptist Church in Garner, off Old Stage Road at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 14th.

Larry was born June 26, 1942, in Little Rock, Ark., to Lafayette Cobb and Avis McFalls Cope. Larry attended L.D. Bell High School from 1956 to 1959. During Vietnam, he served as a Lance Corporal in the Marine Corps, where he received a recommendation for a Bronze Star.
